Application for Project Funding and Resourcing

Philosophy:

It is energy4everyone's philosophy to foster partnerships with other organizations sharing common values and goals. The intent of energy4everyone is not to solely provide funding, however it is to partner with other Not for Profit, Charitable, and Non Government Organizations on projects or easily identifiable project elements which focus primarily on the provision of energy services and technology that will directly improve the access to modern energy, while supporting the creation of prosperous futures for those living in communities in need around the world. The Canadian energy sector can offer more valuable resource than funding alone; the breadth of knowledge, experience and expertise of its employees.

Eligibility:

energy4everyone is focused on sustainable development. In order to successfully implement such a mandate, the applicant organization must work in collaboration with the local community in need to design a program that will ensure the appropriate energy and technology are selected and that the community benefits from a long-term, positive impact in the form of access to modern energy. Any organization requesting program funding must be a Registered Canadian Charity, however, the Human Resource Pool is open to Not for Profit, Charitable, Non Government Organizations and energy entrepreneurs, from any developing country, who require energy sector technical assistance and training.

In order for a project to be eligible for energy4everyone funding or resourcing the following criteria must be met:

- The project must align with the legal objects of energy4everyone: the relief of poverty; helping communities in need; and the delivery or deployment of energy services or energy technology;
- An estimate of the positive economic, environmental and health impact on the recipient community must be determined;
- The level of project sustainability, in terms of the expressed community want and, where applicable, community financial commitment must be proven; and
- The project must be consistent with the strategic rationale and meet one or more of the following segments in which energy4everyone operates or seeks to operate.
 1. **Fund of Funds:** energy4everyone will provide grants to those identified Canadian organizations that are established, experienced and credible, with a strong business model and operational execution. The funding may be provided to assist such organizations in achieving their next growth stage or as part of a smart investment that leverages an existing investment or project.
 2. **Micro-Finance Subsidy Program:** energy4everyone will provide loans or subsidies with micro-finance companies to ensure funding is available to individual consumers or micro-businesses to purchase modern energy services and technologies and create capacity. All loans will be non-

interest bearing, and all collected monies transitioned back into the program community by way of a revolving fund.

3. **Human Resource Pool:** energy4everyone will have a resource pool of energy company employees available to become involved in specific projects in roles ranging from program management to technical, feet on the ground, assistance, training and capacity development.
4. **Community Development & Assistance:** energy4everyone will target institutions such as schools, hospitals/medical clinics, government/community centre building and orphanages where the energy needs exist, but where there is little or no economic capacity to address that need. Addressing the energy poverty needs of specific institutional sites, will realize a significant reduction in operating costs, freeing up funds and time to focus on the community support each respective institution provides.
5. **Innovation & Mentorship Program:** energy4everyone will support and encourage socially minded inventors with the aim of creating low cost and sustainable technologies that could be economically introduced in developing countries for manufacture, distribution and consumption by providing some level of financing, technical resource assistance and/or networking with appropriate organizations.
